Fort Henry Buckskinners is a family oriented, non-profit club located in eastern Idaho. Members enjoy learning and living the lifestyle of the early 1800s, the fur trade era of the mountain man. Leather working and historical crafting, primitive fire starting, black



powder gun shooting, knife and tomahawk throwing, and traditional archery are just a few of the activities we strive to learn and practice at our annual rendezvous. This event, held near Ashton in early June each year, is open to anyone interested to watch or participate. Rendezvous includes trader booths that sell interesting and useful traditional goods, games and challenges for the entire family, and both primitive and modern camping. Families and guests get a chance to leave behind modern concerns, to see and feel the life of those who came before us.

The Fort Henry Buckskinners are excited to celebrate their 30th year anniversary of the Fort Henry's Mountain Men Rendezvous. Curly and a few other mountain men 30 years ago held the first rendezvous on Fall River just east of Chester. Years later the Fort Henry Buckskinners relocated to the Keith Nyborg property for their Rendezvous. The past it years they have held the Rendezvous in the Parker/Egin area along the Henry's Fork.

This year they are excited to hold their Rendezvous east of Ashton off of the Cave Falls highway next to Robinson Creek. They will have paper shoots for muzzle loaders, a woods walk, hawk and knife trail walk, archery, cannon shoot, a candy cannon, and crafts for children up to age 99. Traders with arts and crafts and primitive gear and supplies will also be on site. When attending you are encouraged to wear pioneer/ primitive clothing from the 1840's era. The events are open to the public Wednesday, June 5-Sunday, June 9. Hours will be Wed.-Sat. 9-5 and Sunday 9-12.
