The Fremont County Smart Growth Coalition will sponsor and educational forum on the control and eradication of noxious weeds in the Fremont County areas. The forum will be a brief presentation on their programs by representatives of the US Forest Service, the Bureau of Land Management, the Fremont County Weed Control Department, a local business that uses goats and other environmental tools in the control of noxious weeds, and a prominent local farmer.
