## Business Spotlight: Desert Dog Sled Dog Adventures

to spotlight our newest business member Desert Dog Sled Dog Adventures. Linda Janssen and her partner Dave Harman started kicking around an idea of a new business in 2010. With Ashton's history of the American Dog Derby and their love of mushing, they felt that they were ready to share that love with others. The business took off by word of mouth from other mushers. And it was done; the **Desert Dog Sled Dog Adventures** was in business. Already giving rides and tours to people from Ashton to Minnesota to France! Desert Dog Sled Dog Adventures offers sled dog rides and tours in Idaho's high desert country near the Tetons and Yellowstone Park. The entire business is a team effort! With Linda and Dave at the head of the pack, their team also consists of Matt & Mindy Reymann who help with running the tours and caring for the dog teams, and the 28 dogs are also an important part of the team working hard to earn their keep! Most of the dogs are Alaskan Huskies and two of them are Seppala Siberian Husky. This year Linda raced 6 pups she has raised herself and did very well; placing fourth here in Ashton at the American Dog Derby and recently placing third at a race in Logan. Linda and Dave have built a "dog camp" west of town where they keep their dogs. This is the home of **Desert Dog Sled Dog Adventures**. When you call to do business with them, part of the adventure will be getting a tour of dog camp. Their business is to excite and give everyone an opportunity to learn that there is more to being a musher than just standing on the back of a sled and yelling a command. They will give you a short 101 mushing course on what work it takes to be a musher, as well as a kennel tour to meet & greet the dogs. One of Dave's jobs is to groom the trails. They have their own groomer, so Dave grooms the trail and checks for wildlife before your adventure begins. Since 1917 Ashton has been home to the American Dog Derby, but how many of you locals have ever been on a dog sled? Here's your chance! Just give Linda or Dave a call and they will be happy to take you for the ride of your life! We live in prime country for dog racing. The **Desert Dog Sled Dog Adventures** is family friendly fun! They have various packages that are reasonably priced for different distances and wants whether you prefer to ride and enjoy the scenery or are ready to learn how to be a musher yourself!
