### A Call to Action: Chamber/ City of Ashton Partnership on the Visitors' Center

Every summer, over 1 million cars travel on Hwy 20 by Ashton. The Ashton Visitors' Center has a unique opportunity to direct many of those to our local businesses. Last year, we failed to take advantage of this. The Visitors' Center was only open three days a week due to a lack of volunteers. Chamber President Linda Janssen has proposed that we not allow this to happen again.

The Chamber of Commerce is undertaking a partnership with the City of Ashton to ensure the Visitors' Center can be open at least six days a week. We need your help, as citizens of the Ashton community, members of the Chamber, and owners of local businesses. For a few hours of your time, you will not only help drive customers to all Ashton area businesses, but you will get some free advertising for your own.

To expand the roll of volunteers at the Visitors' Center, we are asking member businesses and organizations to cover one or more days at the center. While your group is running the center, you can promote your business or organization in any manner you choose. Some ideas are signs out front, displays in the center, or sales of your wares. Be creative! The Chamber is working with Jackie Vaughn the newly hired director of the Visitors' Center to arrange a schedule. Whole and half day slots will be available. We estimate we will need to cover 25-30 days across the entire summer to ensure maximum availability to travelers on Hwy 20. The City and Chamber will be providing a list of Frequently Asked Questions and Answers to help the volunteers' direct travelers to local stores and points of interest. What a wonderful opportunity for young people in our community to connect with visitors and learn more about our area. Additionally, the Chamber will be refitting the information kiosks outside of the Visitors' Center. They need some minor repairs and clean-up. Most important, they need new local information on stores, restaurants, hotels, and points of interest. We need Chamber Members to provide the information to go in the kiosks, and we need some volunteers to help with the refit.


