On June 23, Chamber President, Linda Janssen, submitted a letter to the Idaho Transportation Department - District 6.

The letter was sent to address issues created by the detour of traffic due to the construction on U.S. 20 on the Ashton Hill. Our Ashton-Area businesses have noticed a considerable impact on tourist traffic, which is our primary market throughout the summer months. The impact of the detour on our business community comes at a crucial time of year. Many of our businesses depend on summer sales to get them through the year.

The letter stated, "We understand it is necessary during the week to divert traffic to Interstate 15 in order to alleviate congestion along the U.S. 20 – Ashton Hill corridor; however, during the weekend, there is no construction work being done, and both lanes of traffic are open. In order to avert any further economic damage to Ashton and the surrounding area, we asked that IDT detour onto Interstate 15 only from midnight Sunday to midnight Thursday and that Friday thru Sunday traffic be encouraged to use U.S. 20."

Linda received a call from a ITD representative the same week that the letter was mailed, and he was very empathetic and responsive to our town's issues and concerns. He agreed to change the signage at the detour in Idaho Falls to state that traffic was open on US Highway 20 during the weekend.

Needless to say, we have heard from some local businesses that this year's 4th of July weekend business was the best ever!
