



The Teton Geotourism Center (TGC), located in downtown Driggs, Idaho, opened August 1, 2014, to serve the people and communities located along the Teton Scenic Byway, which runs from Ashton to Swan Valley. The TGC is the first geotourism center in the world, and serves as a vibrant visitors center, providing travel resources and free WI-fi for tourist, 24/7. During business hours, the TGC is staff by local volunteers who answer questions and help visitors with itinerary planning.

The TGC is also home to beautiful, interactive exhibits that tell stories of the history, natural assets, and lifestyles along the Teton Scenic Byway. These exhibits were created by a team of community volunteers from all five Byway communities, and include highlights of our local history, recreational activities, industry, culture, and natural beauty. Five gorgeous painted murals set the scenes for several exhibits, and more than 200 photographs by local photographers portray our unique environment.

The TGC is open Monday - Friday 9:00 – 5:00; Saturday 10:00 – 4:00; and Sundays noon – 4:00. Bring your family to enjoy the activities and informative videos and educational content.
