Each year, on the third weekend in February, Ashton is transformed into a world of howling



dogs, curious spectators, and anxious racers. Dating back to 1917, the **American Dog Derby** is the oldest sled dog race in America still being run. We are gearing up for a grand celebration next week for the 100th anniversary! What makes it unique is the "carnival-like" atmosphere that prevails during the race. Unlike most races that start and finish in obscure locations, this derby event is located in <u>Ashton</u> and attracts hundreds of spectators both days. The great tradition is made possible by the generous donations we receive from our supporters.
