- 1. There is a \$10 Chamber of Commerce fee for having a booth on Main Street and/or in the City Park.
- 2. If you have a booth on Main Street and move it to the City Park after the parade it will cost you an additional \$10.
- 3. A moving booth; whether it be a wagon, cooler, 4wheeler, etc. is also a \$10 Chamber of Commerce fee.
- 4. If you already own a business on Main Street you will not be charged the \$10 fee. (i.e., sidewalk sale)
- 5. ALL vendors will need to fill out a waiver prior to selling.
