Fall River Electric Cooperative has initiated a fundraising effort to construct a smallscale distributed generation system at North Fremont High School. The installed system will consist of a wind turbine and solar panels similar to this photo. The system will



include a real-time display, teacher training and classroom materials to help integrate into the school's curriculum.

Businesses and utilities nationwide are facing a changing energy landscape – including growing interest by consumers for renewable energy options. Fall River Electric intends to give students at North Fremont a head start toward understanding and using these technologies. Even though the city of Ashton and North Fremont High School are not served by Fall River Electric, the Cooperative is dedicated to educating our youth about a changing future and about the possibilities of renewable energy.

The total cost of the project is about \$35,000. The Cooperative has secured a \$10,000 grant plus is contributing an additional \$15,000 to the project in an effort to help the school provide education that will benefit students for several decades.
