Business Spotlight: ⁸lue Mountain Trophy **Frout Fishing**

Lynn and Janet Bowman bought the old fish hatchery in November 2016. They moved to Ashton from Central Montana. Lynn and Janet knew each other back in the 70's; but went their separate ways. However, in 1996 their separate ways led them right back to each other and they were married. Between the two of them they have 7 children. Janet enjoys baking and cooking and enjoying small town life. When not tending to the fishing business, Lynn enjoys archery hunting.

Blue Mountain Trophy Trout Fishing's history actually starts way back in the 70's when Lynn started a trout hatchery on his mother's ranch in Calaveras County, California. Lynn had just returned and finished a nerve wracking tour of duty in Vietnam. PTSD was front and center. It raised havoc with his nervous system. Lynn says, "I guess the raising of trout sort of got me back to my normal self. I stopped dwelling and feeling sorry for myself, and put my energy into raising trout." During his early years of raising trout he somewhat lucked out and "accidently" developed a special technique of spawning. He consistently produced 99.9% of trout eggs to hatch. Lynn learned a lot at the old hatchery in California, but eventually he had to shut down the hatchery for lack of sufficient water flow.

Over time, Lynn ended up raising Rocky Mountain elk on a large ranch in central Montana. It was a very successful business, but bad luck came again when the Montana FWP decided to shut down all the game ranches in the state. Lynn claims he's had a fair share of bad luck, but has a determined attitude.

When the old fish hatchery went for sale, Lynn said, "Idaho, here I come!" He decided it was time to get back to his old habits of raising beautiful Rainbow, Brook, and Cutthroat trout. So he is spawning trout at the old Ashton Trout Hatchery and everything in between. With his love of hunting and fishing, Lynn hopes to have a couple of very nice large trout fishing lakes here in Eastern Idaho. It will be a catch and keep, and catch and release program. Anyone interested in viewing some nice trout are very welcome to come to Blue Mountain Trophy Trout Fishing and see what they have to offer. Parties interested in stocking private ponds, please give Blue Mountain Trophy Trout Fishing a call!
