Mesa Falls

A must-see when visiting Ashton, Mesa Falls features spectacular upper and lower waterfalls surrounded by lush forest. The scenic byway leading to the falls is beautiful in itself, and a stop at Warm River along the way is well worth it. Feed the fish or enjoy a relaxing float down Warm River or the Henry's Fork—perfect for families and casual adventurers alike. Cave Falls & Horseshoe Lake

Located in the southwest of Yellowstone National Park, Cave Falls is a wide and powerful waterfall with minimal crowds and peaceful surroundings. On your way there, stop at Horseshoe Lake, a hidden gem perfect for fishing, swimming, and paddleboarding. It's a quiet spot that captures the essence of Idaho's wild beauty.

Harriman Horseback Rides
